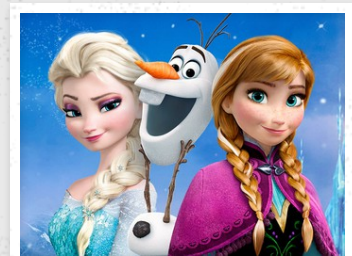


## PICTURE DAY UPDATE!
