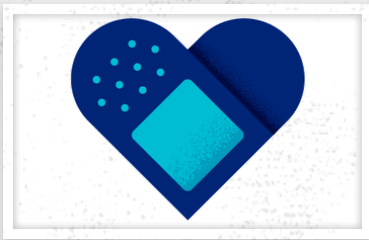
ROBOTICS CLUB

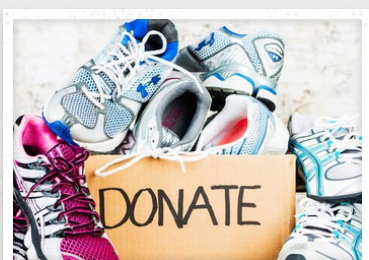
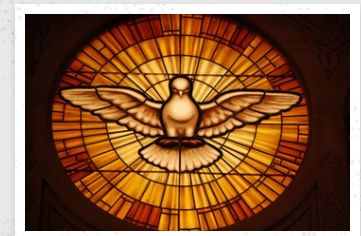
FLU VACCINES COMING TO SAINT ALOYSIUS!
