Welcome to 3rd grade! Let the fun begin with.... Summer reading!

This summer, choose a book to read from the choices below. Then, complete the mandatory writing portion of the Book Report project (attached). Next, choose **one** other project that goes along with the book choice (see ideas below).

Rising 3rd grade students are encouraged to practice reading their books independently. This will be the first formal assessment grade students will receive for the first trimester.

Book Choices

Choose one book from the following. Chocolate Fever, Shiloh, a Magic Tree House Series book, an A-Z Mystery Series book, a Junie B. Jones Series book, an I Survived Series book or a book of your choice (on or above reading level).

Choose One...

- Make a poster advertising your book.
- Use iMovie on your device to create a trailer for your book.
- Send a postcard from one of the characters. Draw a picture on one side; write the message on the other.
- Choose a character. Tell whether or not you would want him/her for a sibling, or parent, or friend, and why.
- Create a timeline of the major events in your book. Use drawings or magazine cutouts to show the events along the timeline. Label each event with a sentence.
- Draw a portrait of the main character and write a paragraph description of the character to accompany your sketch.
- Make up a different ending for the story. Include drawings/sketches to illustrate the changes.
- If the author is still alive, write to him/her explaining what you liked about the book. Send your letter through the USPS. Turn in a copy of the letter. You might get a reply!
